As you may know, I am the new Executive Director of Blue Skies for Children. I took on this role last January and have been spending the last several months learning all I can about the community we serve, the programs we offer, and the resources required to effectively accomplish our mission. In 2022, Blue Skies for Children experienced multiple staffing changes that impacted some of our standard operating procedures. During this time, our **Sponsor-A-Child** program continued to flourish with one significant difference – consistent communication with YOU!

As our new staff got comfortable in their roles and things stabilized, we recognized that we had an opportunity to streamline communications, focus our energy on program delivery, and to also address some concerns about client confidentiality and equity within our Sponsor-A-Child Program. As a result, we are re-engaging with you, our Sponsor-A-Child donor, to provide program updates and to share how your donations have provided valuable enrichment and learning opportunities for children in our community.

We will no longer be providing children's photos or assigning a child to a specific donor. This change provides a greater level of confidentiality for our families and allows our staff to spend less time on matching children to donors and more time on providing program services. But we will continue sharing personal impact stories on a quarterly basis to keep our donors informed and connected to our work!
